DEADLINE EXTENDED

TUESDAY, MARCH 2, 2010

Entry through track wrestling must be done by Tuesday, March 2, 2010 at 10:00pm. All payments must be received at the Sports Commission by Thursday, March 4, 2010. Because of the tremendous interest in the Park City-Wichita Wrestling Classic, only 1,400 competitors will be accepted. Entry is on a first come, first serve basis and the Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission reserves the right to refuse service and may cease taking applicants at any time. Entries will be cutoff when the maximum number of participants has been reached. All entries are final.

RULES

KSHSAA rules will apply with Kansas Kids' modifications. Age requirements for wrestlers is listed as of **August 31, 2009**. **All wrestlers must have a current USA Wrestling card.** Head gear is required. There will be a doctor present at the weigh in. Wrestlers with any skin disorders **MUST** have a medical sheet filled out and signed by their doctor. Coaches / wrestlers **ONLY** will be allowed on the wrestling floor. Parents or wrestlers not competing will **NOT** be allowed matside. Coolers are **PROHIBITED**. Smoking will **NOT** be allowed in the building.

Seeding Information

In order to help us seed the brackets correctly, it is important to list all the information that is requested on the entry form. If you do not provide us with any of the information, your wrestler will be seeded as a "D" wrestler for the Classic and placed on the bracket accordingly.

Weight Changes

Friday Night Weigh-Ins Only. Satellite Weigh-Ins will be offered at select locations.

Combining Weight Groups

The Park City - Wichita Wrestling Classic organizers reserve the right to combine any weight groups they feel are necessary.

WRESTLING TIME PERIODS

All back door matches for 12, 14 and high school age divisions will be three (3), one (1) minute time periods. No 1 1/2 minute time periods for back door matches.

Wrestlers in small groups will be combined with a larger group.

No bracket will be larger than 32 participants.

A non-rated wrestler will be considered a "D" wrestler and accordingly placed on the tournament bracket.

AWARDS

NEW UPGRADED AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN TO PLACES 1-4

Outstanding Wrestler Trophy in each age division. The Outstanding Wrestler must be a champion and the award is based on the champion with the most falls in the least amount of time.

Team Trophies awarded in each division to the team with the most points after the championship round. No team will be awarded more than one team trophy.

Points will be awarded as follows: First Place - 14 Points; Second Place - 10 Points; Third Place - 7 Points; Fourth Place - 4 Points

It is the coach's responsibility to inform his wrestling club's parents and participants of the rules of the Park City-Wichita Wrestling Classic. Any flagrant or repeated violations by any coach, parent, spectator or wrestler will be cause for immediate eviction from the tournament and may cause a contestant to be disqualified. All tournament rules will be strictly enforced by tournament security. All spectators and contestants are to observe and obey the rules and regulations of the Kansas Coliseum and Pavilion II.
